FORM 990 INFORMATION

Attention Beta Theta Pi Chapter Presidents:

All chapters are required to file Form 990 with the Internal Revenue Service by April 15th or the 15th of the fifth month after the close of the fiscal year. *Example: Most chapters are on a Fiscal Year ending June 30th, therefore, the 990 File date is November 15th.*

Instructions for Form 990 require that the chapter enter Line "I" the General Fraternity's Group Exemption Number (GEN)#0315.

All chapters that are required to file Form 990 need to forward a copy of the Form 990 to the Administrative Office for permanent record. If a chapter neglects to file a Form 990 with the IRS, the IRS will notify the chapter, requesting compliance.

If necessary, the chapter can file an Extension (Form 7004) that grants the chapter three additional months to file. The request for extension must be files with the IRS by the original date for filing Form 990.

If your chapter is required to file a 990 and neglects to file, your chapter can be assessed a penalty up to \$10,000 by the IRS and have your chapters tax exempt status revoked. This revocation would result in the IRS requiring your chapter to pay corporate income tax (approx. 40%).
