- · describe the mission and vision of Beta Theta Pi as a General Fraternity.
- **practice leadership skills** which build credible officers, executive committees and advisory teams of Beta Theta Pi.
- practice leadership-based decision making that promotes ongoing individual and chapter self-governance and accountability.
- **devise and implement action plans** aimed at bringing the principles and obligations of Beta Theta Pi to life in their chapters, in their fraternity/sorority communities and in themselves.
